Zoom is a HIPAA compliant live video conferencing service that allows screen sharing so the people on the conference can see what's on your computer.

Use with Everyday Speech:

Share your screen & sound with students to watch videos together. Use the pen tool to annotate, or draw on the screen. If you're playing a game or using an interactive worksheet, allow students to control the mouse and manage the activity from their computer.

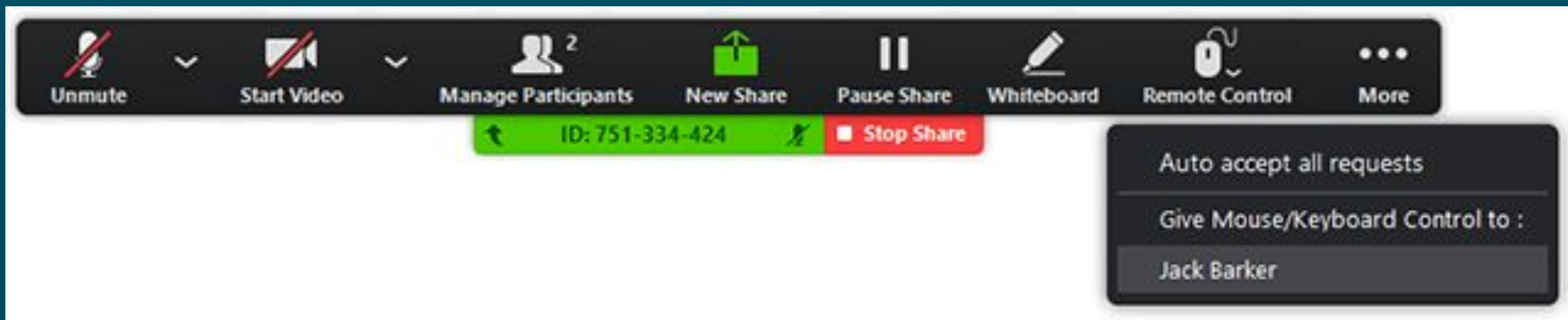

Kami is available as an extension for Google Chrome and integrates with Google Drive, Google Classroom, and Canvas.

Use with Everyday Speech:

Have students watch a video, then open the Video Companion Worksheet (PDF) in Kami and circle the main character, type their answers, or draw what emotion a character is feeling.
