3. Cut out both hands and paste them on the labelled tabs on the world

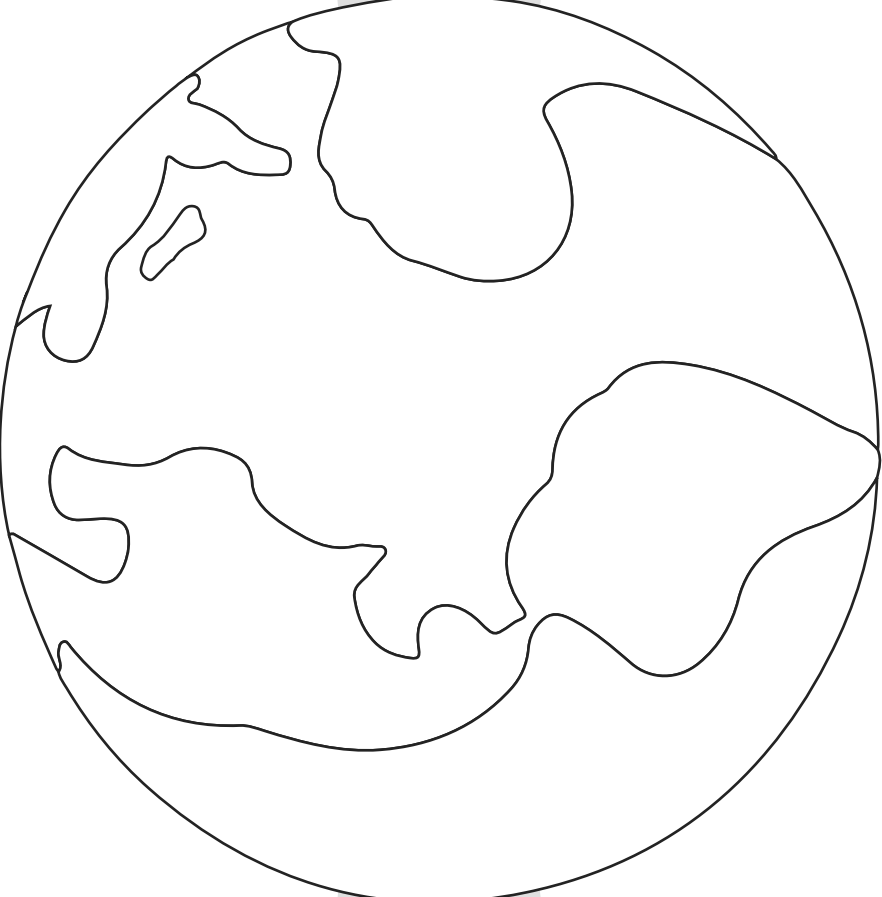
